(All times are CST/CDT)

March 8, 7:54 pm - New Moon, 7:57 pm - Total Solar Eclipse

Season of the Witch

Effects of eclipses may last for about six months. The time between two eclipses (March 8 - 23) is the season of the witch. Gods – Hare, Green Man, Youthful Gods, Warrior Gods, Taliesin, Lord of the Greenwood (English), Dagda (Irish), Cernunnos (Greco-Celtic), Pan (Greek), Adonis (Greek)

Essence – strength, birthing, completion, power, love, sexuality, embodiment of spirit, fertility, opening, beginning

Dynamics/Meaning – the God comes of age, sexual union of the Lord & Lady, sprouting, greening, balance of light and dark

Purpose – plant and animal fertility, sowing

Rituals/Magick – spellcrafting, invention, new growth, new projects, seed blessing

Customs – wearing green, new clothes, Celtic bird festival, egg baskets coloring eggs, collecting birds eggs, bird watching, egg hunts, starting new projects, spring planting

Foods – light foods, fish, maple sugar candies, hot crossed buns, sweet breads, hard boiled eggs, honey cakes, seasonal fruits, milk punch, egg drinks

Herbs – acorns, celandine, tansy, cinquefoil, crocus, daffodil, dogwood, Irish moss, ginger, honeysuckle, iris, jasmine, rose, hyssop, linden, strawberry, violets

Element/Gender – air/male

Threshold – dawn

The Hawk Moon

March brings the Hawk Moon. As the sun warms the soil, rising thermals attract the attention of soaring birds, who use them to conserve energy. Hawks hunt by scanning the landscape for motion, and then swoop down from high above. This month you may see these birds of prey circling overhead as they look for food. Hawks symbolize insight, vision, and foresight.

The March spell focuses on keen sight, both physical and metaphysical. You'll need a telescope or binoculars, paper, and pencil. Go somewhere that you can see the horizon. Notice how it looks from a distance. Then call on the spirit of Hawk to grant you vision. Look at the horizon through the telescope. See how different it looks. Imagine the coming year and your plans for it. Jot down your ideas for pursuing your goals. You may also want to sketch the horizon, comparing the distant and magnified images. Look at the horizon again without the telescope and see if you can identify anything that you first spotted with the telescope.

Afterwards, thank the spirit of Hawk for aiding you. Keep your notes on your altar so you can refer back to them during the year.

Black Tourmaline - Ancient shamans relied upon Black Tourmaline, known as Schorl, to protect them from earth demons as they cast their spells. Today, this stone is still revered as a premier talisman of protection, and as a psychic shield deflecting and dispelling negative energies, entities, or destructive forces. It guards against radiation and environmental pollutants and is highly useful in purifying and neutralizing one's own negative thoughts and internal conflicts, while turning them into positive, usable energy.

Black Tourmaline is also a powerful grounding stone. It is electrical in nature, providing a connection between Earth and the human spirit. Its supportive energy aligns the energy centers of the body and channels healing light throughout the system. Spell of the Month

Egg Divination

Oomancy is a form of divination by eggs. There are many methods of egg divination. Probably the most well-known is to choose an egg. The egg is then carefully pierced and the white is blown or poured out into a clear glass or bowl of warm water. The egg white forms shapes and patterns which are then interpreted in much the same way as scrying.

Another form of egg divination is performed by holding a whole raw egg cradled in both hands while focusing on a question or issue. Some time should be spent in meditation of the question or issue with eyes closed. Break the egg into a clear glass or bowl of water. Examine the egg for marks that may indicate the answer to the question or the solution to the problem.

An egg can be used to determine whether or not someone has been given the evil eye. A whole raw egg in the shell is passed over the body. The egg is gently rolled along the skin surface from the top of the body to the waist, along both arms from shoulder to fingers, and down both legs to the toes and heels. The egg may then be cracked into a clear glass or bowl of water. The contents are then examined. If the egg contains blood or any strange matter, this is considered to be a sure sign that the person has been given the evil eye.

As symbols of beginnings, eggs may also point you in unexplored directions or at least give you new information that you may have overlooked before asking your divinatory question.

Not only do eggs serve as wonderful oracular tools that you can perform divinations with, but when you've finished, you can eat them as well, feeding on the wisdom you have uncovered.
